Benjamin Brodsky, CFA, Managing Director, is global head of Fixed Income Asset Allocation and Emerging Markets for BlackRock's Model-Based Fixed Income Portfolio Management Group.

Mr. Brodsky's service with the firm dates back to 2002, including his years with Barclays Global Investors (BGI), which merged with BlackRock in 2009. At BGI, he was global head of fixed income asset allocation and led the design and implementation of the firm's approach to allocating across a wide set of fixed income asset classes. In addition, as co-head of emerging markets, he had responsibility for BGI's investment strategies in external emerging market debt and emerging market currencies. Prior to joining BGI he was portfolio manager for Salomon Brothers Asset Management specialising in emerging market and corporate debt.

Mr. Brodsky earned a BA degree in international economics and business studies from the University of Dusseldorf and the Institut Commercial de Nancy and earned an MSc degree in financial engineering from the ICMA Centre, Henley Business School, University of Reading.
